Strings Classes

Early Beginning Strings

Ages 5-7. Students will learn the basics of violin, viola, or cello. This class will be taught by Michelle Vaughn.

Beginning Strings

Ages 8 and up. Students will learn the basics of violin, viola, cello, or bass. This class will be taught by Nancy Chott.

Silver Strings

For students with one or two years of experience. This orchestra will be conducted by Kara Hunnicutt.

Gold Strings

For students with three or more years of experience. This orchestra will be conducted by Bret Smith.

Chamber Music

All students will participate in small ensembles of three to eight musicians. Their rehearsals will be lead by a faculty coach. The students will perform on Friday during the afternoon chamber music time.



Attention String Teachers:

Electives

Students will get to choose four electives during their week at Prep Summer Strings! Below is a brief description of each. Please rank your choices on the registration form.

Gymnastics—CharRe Burnum

Students climb, jump, and play on the gymnastic equipment that CharRe brings!

Knitting—Nancy Chott

A beginning level basic knitting lesson is taught by Nancy Chott. Students will start a neck scarf and will be able to take it home to finish.

Experimental Orchestra—Michelle Vaughn

Students will be given a chance to try out a new instrument while learning fiddle tunes. Violins, violas, cellos, and basses will be available and the students will learn beginning techniques of each.

Improvisation—Dr. Bret Smith

Students will explore creative and expressive music-making on their instruments through improvisation activities on their major instruments. Learn some new styles of playing!

The Music of Movement—Kim Roy

CWU conducting masters graduate Kim Roy will lead students into the basics of orchestra conducting and explore how body movement and music making are connected. Anyone can be a conductor!

Polymer Clay—Kara Hunnicutt

Students will create jewelry or sculpt figures using polymer clay. This elective includes an additional \$5 materials fee.
